# Kentucky Local Masters Swimming Committee Meeting December 3, 2018

Chair C.J. Rushman called the meeting to order at 11:19 a.m. at Lakeside Swim Club in Lexington. Also present were Secretary Meg Smath (WILD), Treasurer Dave Burgio (WILD), Registrar Susan Ehringer (SLM), William Kolb (LAKE), Christina Yeoman (WILD), Jim Luebbe (BST), Pam Luebbe (LAKE), Julie May (CARD), Bill Tingley (CARD), Tom Mester (SLM).

**President's report.** C.J. announced that the USMS Leadership Summit will be held March 1–3, 2019, in Phoenix. It is held in odd years, and most of the attendees are LMSC chairs. C.J. would normally attend as Kentucky LMSC chair and also as a member of the LMSC Development and Volunteers Task Force, but he will not be able to attend this year. Anyone who would like to attend in his place should let him know. C.J. will work with Dave to estimate a budget item for airfare to the meeting. Unfortunately, the date conflicts with the Wildcat meet. Since that means C.J. will also not be able to attend the Wildcat meet, he suggested we have our 2019 annual meeting after the Maehr Mile on Feb. 24 instead. This was acceptable to all delegates.

The USAS convention will be in St. Louis Sept. 12–16. C.J. noted this will be his last year as Great Lakes Zone chair, which will make him an automatic delegate. Susan will also be automatic as Registration Committee chair. USMS President Patty Miller has not yet made committee assignments, so we don't know yet who else will have automatic status; assuming Meg is reappointed to Legislation and Bill is reappointed as parliamentarian, they would be automatic delegates. We will be entitled to our usual two LMSC delegates, but getting at-large delegate appointments may be more difficult this year. Should we be unable to obtain two at-large appointments as we have in recent years we will need to decide if we still want to send the same number of delegates as we have been sending, even if some of them will not be able to vote. We will decide this at the annual meeting. William will go ahead and reserve rooms assuming our usual number of delegates; we can always cancel rooms later, if needed. The delegates will have a preconvention meeting in Louisville after the long-course mini-meet, tentatively set for July 7. If Lakeside is not available, Jim offered space at Blairwood.

C.J. announced he has appointed Julie as the LMSC's Open Water chair.

**Treasurer's report.** The financial reports from Dave Burgio are attached. Dave noted that they are accurate as of Oct. 31; he has not yet received the November statements, but expects the only change to be a \$180 deposit from USMS. Total income for the year is slightly above budget and convention expenses are also ahead of budget. Therefore, we are on track to surpass our budget for 2018. Dave noted that we are currently receiving a very low rate on our money market at US Bank. He has investigated and found we can get a better rate at Vanguard. MSA to move the money market account to Vanguard; Dave Burgio and Meg Smath are authorized to act in this matter on the LMSC's behalf. Susan commented that members registering for 2019 have donated \$105 to the LMSC so far. Meg offered to repay at least part of the cost of her plane ticket to the convention in Jacksonville since she was unable to stay for the entire convention. The delegates appreciated her gesture but unanimously declined repayment.

**Registrar's report.** Susan Ehringer's report is attached. Susan, as always, is trying to go green, but so far for the 2019 registration year 29 people have asked for printed card. She is emailing each to ask if they are serious or if they just got carried away with checking off boxes.

**Top 10 recorder's report.** Bill Tingley's report is attached. He noted that the long-course times were slower this year because we held the Pan American Championships instead of Summer Nationals. All meets have been sanctioned for 2018. The Barbara Stevens meet has been sanction for January 2019 and will be held at Bowling Green High School

instead of at Western Kentucky University. Bill called our attention to a document distributed at convention that is a to-do list before hosting a meet. In particular, there must be markings on the deck to assure that bulkheads are set in the correct location, if a bulkhead course is used. Meg will send the sanction application for the Maehr Mile/Wildcat Invitational to Bill asap. Commonwealth Masters is interested in holding a SCY meet but will need to submit a pool measurement form first.

Fitness chair's report. Tom Mester had no report.

Officials chair's report. Pam Luebbe had no report.

**Webmaster's report.** William said our website is up to date, and to let him know of any changes. He noted he can set up pages for workout groups, and said he had received information from WKGG and Shelbyville for that purpose.

**Adult Learn-to-Swim report.** William said the LMSC has two grants coming in: a second one for a clinic in Louisville for \$2,200, and a first grant for Wildcat Masters for \$600. William asked if the LMSC would be in favor of subsidizing the Wildcat clinic if the grant funds are insufficient.

Recess. The LMSC recessed at 12:13 p.m. and came out of recess at 12:28 p.m.

Joanne Tingley Scholarship awards. C.J. reported that the Executive Committee unanimously recommended awarding grants to Christina Yeoman, Andrew Magazine, and William Kolb to cover expenses they incurred to receive Adult-Learn-to-Swim and coaching certifications. MSA to approve the Executive Committee's recommendation. Dave asked that Christina, Andrew, and William forward receipts to him so that he can process their checks. Meg noted that these three applications were submitted after the expenses were incurred because at the time of the expenses, we did not yet have a procedure for preapproval; however, going forward, all grant requests should be submitted in advance, along with an estimate of expenses. The LMSC agreed with this procedure, and William will modify the webpage accordingly.
